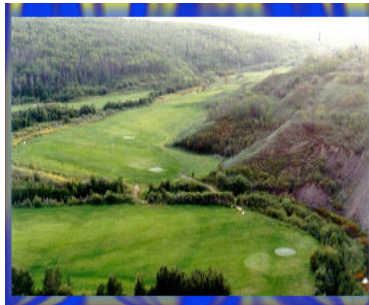

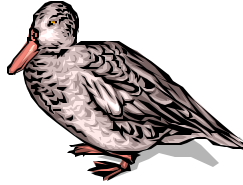

The County of Vermilion River No. 24 covers the area west of the Saskatchewan border, to the Claysmore Road, following the Battle River along the south boundary and takes in almost 6 1/2 townships in ranges 1, 2 and the east half of 3, north of the North Saskatchewan River.

Located within the boundaries are the villages of Dewberry, Marwayne, Kitscoty and Paradise Valley as well as the town of Vermilion. The County boundaries also house the hamlets of Blackfoot, McLaughlin, Rivercourse, Islay, Clandonald, Tulliby Lake and Streamstown.

The Administration Office is situated in the Village of Kitscoty and the Public Works and Gas Utility shops are located about one mile north of the Village of Kitscoty, along Secondary Highway #897.

Highway #16, known as the Yellowhead Route, is almost in the centre of the County and runs through the entire County. As you travel through this route, you will see many grain fields, livestock pasturing in the rolling hills and oil activity.

The pastoral beauty of Vermilion River County is an ideal setting for a getaway. Discover the country museums, shops, local fairs and great summer events like the pro rodeo in Lea Park. Golf amid the rolling hills, hike the green river valleys and boat, swim or fish in the lakes and streams.
